At the Dec. ASC, he did not follow Policy in which any member is allowed to be heard during Open Forum, he also was rude & disrespectful to a valid member of the Area & person that was sent by God Conscience & majority vote of an established Homegroup, to question the actions of said Chairperson in a matter concerning two Policy motions.

That he did by personality & dishonesty, not allow a point to be made in front of the ASC body that questioned his & another member's handling of said motions by meeting in private to address them. As a viable member of this Fellowship, this Area, a recognized Homegroup, involved in service, past elected Area Chairperson, Co-Chairperson & two term Area Policy & Procedure Chair, GSR, & a person that has held or preformed all positions of the ASC body, I deserve the respect of any other member & to be treated as such.

I am here by sending a copy of this to the Area Chairperson, the Area RCM & the Area Webmaster. If this is not addressed officially & properly, I shall attend the next ASC meeting & officially address the entire body, which is well & full within my rights.


