During the discussion about the Regional Budget that needs to be approved by home groups. there was a concern that the budget is twice as much as was actually used. There was a discussion about the fact that the Carolina region is a business, with legal requirements for a budget. There was also a concern that home groups don't get to vote on regional positions. They were reminded that that is the responsibility of our RCM, who we elected to office. There was a suggestion that anyone with concerns to get involved. At the region, you'll see that principles, traditions and concepts are followed. When someone feels that a principle tradition or concept is being violated, it is discussed. Another addict reminded them that the primary purpose of a homegroup is to carry the message. The Carolina Region supports home groups in carrying the message. Whatever your homegroup needs from the Region, let them, or your RCM team know.

The literature will be brought to the July ASC by Ronnie B. to be divided up according to the motion. Lane H offered to bring the literature to the CRSO for resale.

All of the money from literature sales will be earmarked for campvention.
